

Summer Fine Food Market FAQ's

When is the event and what time is it on each day?

- Our Summer Fine Food Market will be held over the August Bank Holiday Weekend - 28th, 29th & 30th August, open 10am - 4pm each day.

Where will the event be located?

- The event will be situated in both our Chestnut & Stable Courtyards. Visitors will enter via the Chestnut Courtyard and a one way operation will be in place to enhance social distancing. Exit will be via the Stable Courtyard (please see map on the website event page).

Do I have to pay for car parking and entry to the event?

- No! We offer free and easy car parking (including disabled car parking) and entry to the event is free of charge.

Can I bring my dog to the event?

- Unfortunately, we will not be allowing dogs into the Fine Food Market for their own comfort as the Courtyards can become crowded.

Can I eat & drink in the Courtyards?

- Yes, eating and drinking is permitted in the Courtyards however we do ask all visitors to be conscious of social distancing and gathering in large groups.

Is a face mask/covering required once I enter the Fine Food Market?

- No, the wearing of face masks/coverings will not be mandatory.

What else is open?

- During each day of the Fine Food Market, we are open as normal. This includes Burghley House & Gardens, The Parkland, The Orangery, The Big Sombrero, The Garden Cafe & Shed, The Courtyard & Garden Shop.

Are toilets open once I enter the Fine Food Market?

- Yes, the toilets in the Chestnut Courtyard will be open.
